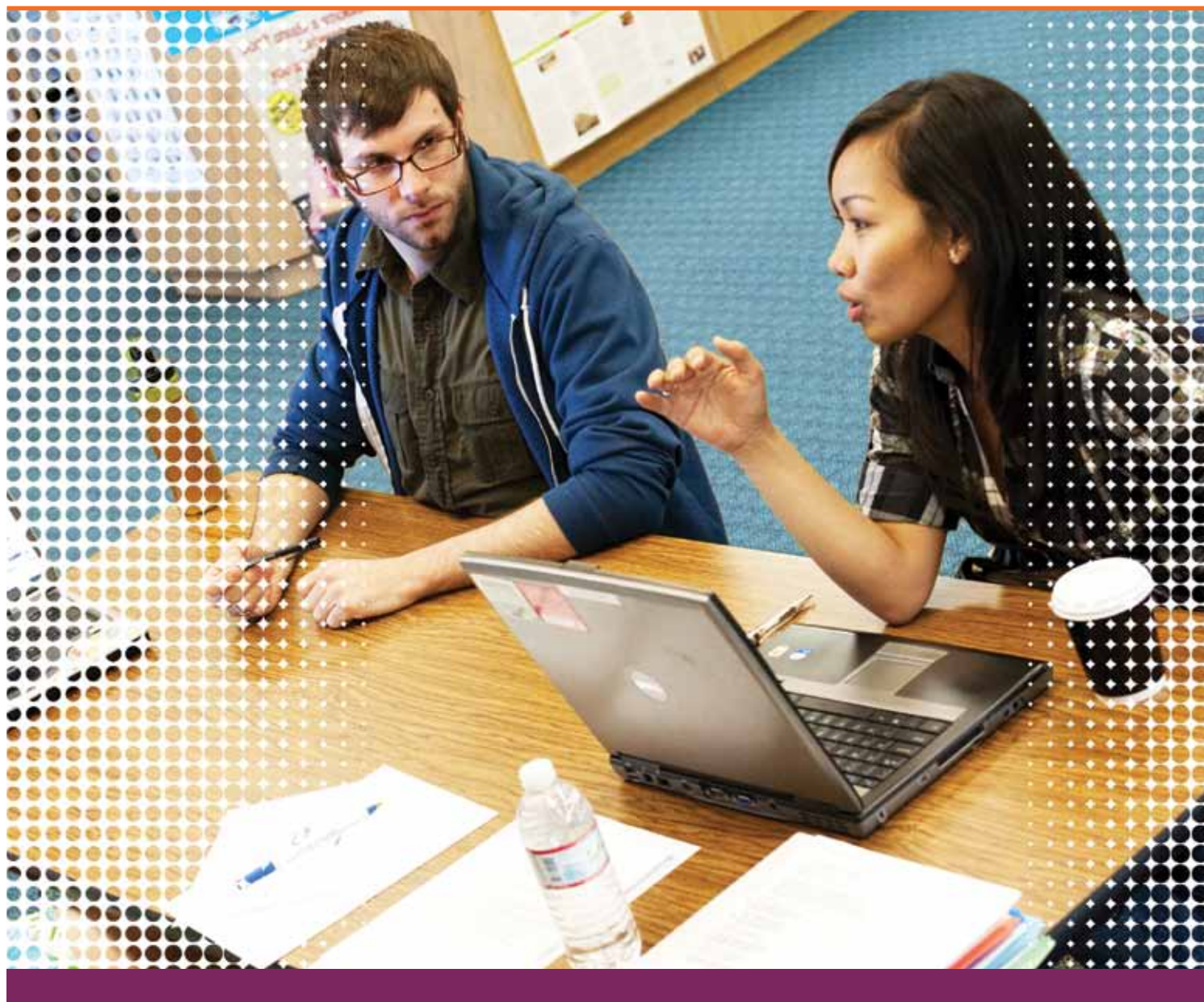

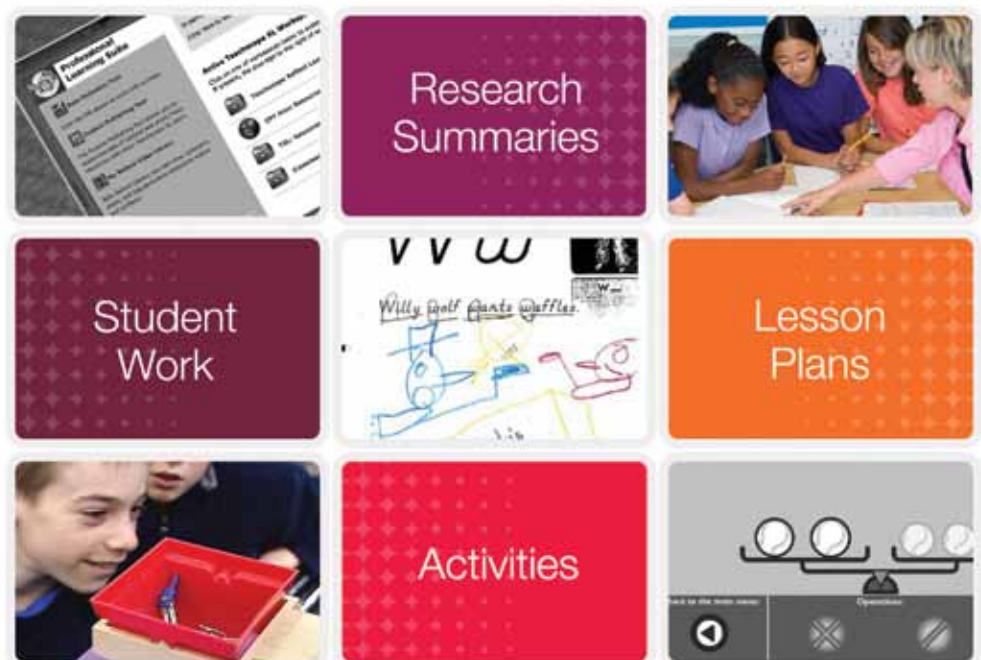

- 124 modules contain more than 2,500 videos and over 10,000 learning resources

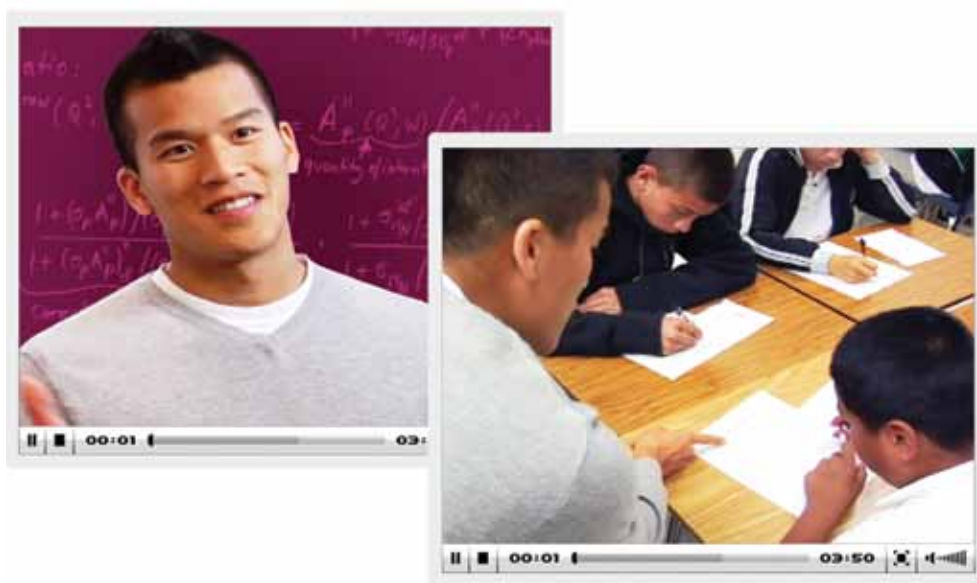
- Research summaries that support the featured practice and help teachers understand why and how the practice works

The Effective Instructional Strategies Series

The New Teacher Support Series

This content library focuses on the foundational knowledge and skills essential to effective teaching. Developed in partnership with the American Federation of Teachers, this library emphasizes research-based strategies and practices for new teachers entering the teaching profession.

The Data Driven Instruction Series

This content library is designed for both school leaders and teachers. The modules for school leaders focus on strategies to improve the ways in which they use data to boost student achievement. The modules for teachers focus on integrating formative assessment techniques and interpreting the data to make instructional decisions that target individual student needs.

The English Language Learners Series

Developed in partnership with Stanford University, this content library focuses on instructional strategies to help students develop English language skills, as well as academic content knowledge.

The Mathematics Series

Developed in partnership with the Concord Consortium, this content library focuses on the pedagogical content knowledge necessary to support the development of students' conceptual understanding of mathematics from the early elementary grades through high school. The modules in this series feature the content, processes, and focal points identified by the National Council of Teachers of Mathematics as essential for students' success.

The Literacy Series
